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Since July 2, 2012

- January 2012, SACS informed the University that a 2nd Monitoring Report was required. In response, the Chancellor established a committee to prepare the report.
- Draft report was completed in mid June and submitted to two consultants. Their feedback changed focus of the 2nd Monitoring Report.
 - From 7 School-level reports
 - To 30 program-level IE (Institutional Effectiveness) reports, which serve as appendices to the Institutional Report
 - All other program-level IE reports (57) to be filed on campus and provided to SACS as requested.




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Since July 2, 2012, contd.

- The focus of the 2nd Monitoring Report changed in mid July, all department chairs focused on preparing their IE reports; the committee leadership changed and a new consultant was hired.
- The 2nd Monitoring was sent to SACS on September 26, 2012, two days ahead of the September 28th deadline.
- Work continued to complete the additional 57 reports, with October 15, 2012, as the deadline.
- This process resulted in an additional 31 completed reports, for a total of 61.




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Breakdown of Reports
