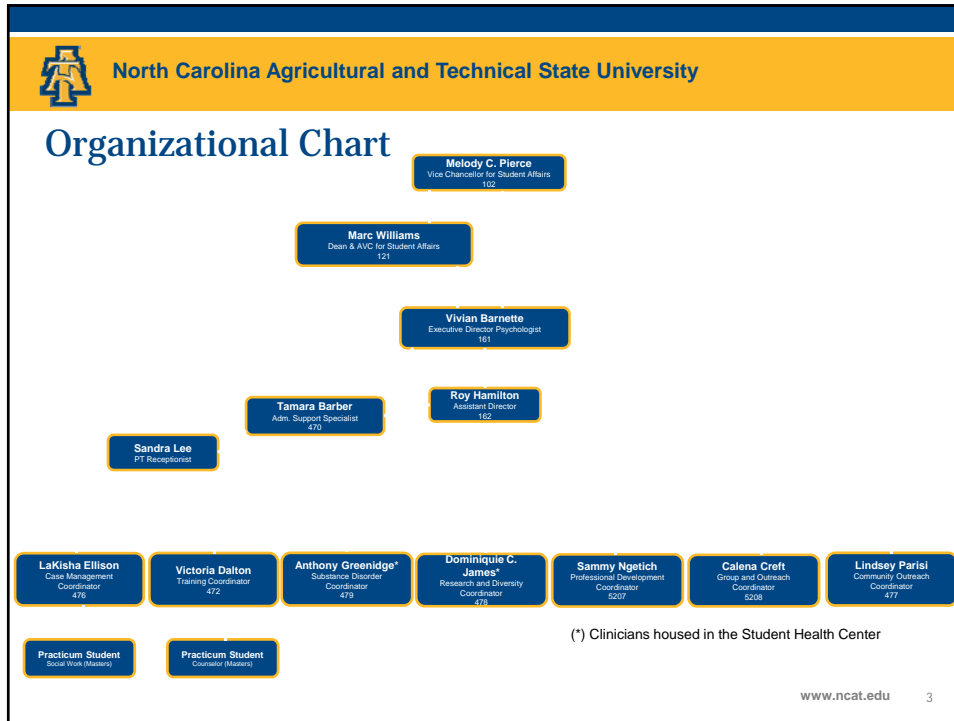
## Purpose

## National and Campus Trends

**Sexual Violence:** Sexual contact by force without consent or when someone is unable to give consent. Programs focus on CONSENT. Dating Violence, Intimate Partner Violence, Stalking, and Bystander Interventions.

**Collegiate Recovery Community (CRC):** Provide support for students in recovery from substance use disorders or addictive behaviors and a home for the sober community. Offer sobriety events. Use of mandated assessment of those sanctioned.


**Resilience Programming:** Teaching protective factors that educate students about emotional well-being, coping and positive help-seeking behavior. Use of outreach, workshops, and classrooms to seek help early and learn effective ways to reduce and/or prevent depression, suicide, stress, anxiety, and increased optimism.

## Grant Funding (2015-2016)

- **Department of Justice-OVW:** Funded 2013-2016, \$497,242
  - » Continuation consortium proposal submitted 4/3/16: \$550,000
- **NC DHHS-Collegiate Recovery Community,** \$125,000
  - » Twice received, continuation possibility
- **SAMHSA-HBCU-CFE:** \$7,500
  - » Successful grant renewal since 2007
- **NC DHHS-Gambling:** \$5,000
  - » Continuous funding since 2012
