

Banner Modules







Graham held the position as interim dean during the 2015-16 academic year. He joined the School of Education in 2003, became a tenure-track assistant professor in 2006 then progressed to the rank of professor. In 2010, Graham was appointed chairman of the Department of Curriculum and Instruction. Within five years, he was promoted to Interim Associate Dean of Graduate Programs. Graham received a Ph.D. in Curriculum and Teaching with a cognate in Multicultural Education and a master's degree in secondary English Education from the University of North Carolina at Greensboro and a bachelor's degree in English from the University at North Carolina at Chapel Hill.

Prior to joining N.C. A&T, Campbell served as an associate dean and professor in the Division of Nursing, at Winston Salem State University. Additionally, she was an associate professor in the School of Nursing at the University of North Carolina at Greensboro. She was also appointed to the U.S. Health Resource and Service Administration. Her research focuses on the health and well-being of children and grandparents in custodial grandparent families. Campbell received a BSN from Florida A & M University, MSN from the University of Maryland, and a Ph.D. from the University of Alabama at Birmingham.

Interim Dean of the College of Science and Technology




Ahmidouch joined N.C. A&T in 1998, after completing a postdoctoral research associate position at Kent State University and at Massachusetts Institute of Technology. He has served as a professor of physics and chair of the Physics Department at N.C. A&T. Ahmidouch has over 25 years of experience in conducting research at the forefront of physics. He is a highly-cited physicist and has authored or co-authored over 122 publications. Ahmidouch holds a Ph.D. in experimental nuclear physics from the University of Geneva-Switzerland and a Master of Science in physics from the University of Grenoble-France.
