**RESOLUTION
CONSTRUCTION OF A
NEW COMMUNITY AND URBAN FOOD COMPLEX**

WHEREAS, North Carolina Agricultural and Technical State University's (University) College of Agriculture and Environmental Sciences received federal funds from the 1890 Facilities Grant Program in the amount of five million six hundred thousand dollars (\$5,600,000) to design and construct a new Community and Urban Food Complex and;

WHEREAS, the College of Agriculture and Environmental Sciences is a leader in forging collaborative partnerships between students, small farmers, consumers and Academic, Research and Extension units to provide education assistance that supports a more sustainable local and community driven food system; and;

WHEREAS, granting the construction of a new Community and Urban Food Complex will support ongoing sustainable food, agricultural and environmental systems programming through our academics, research, and extension enterprises.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees of North Carolina Agricultural and Technical State University approves the facility to be constructed on the University Farm.
