



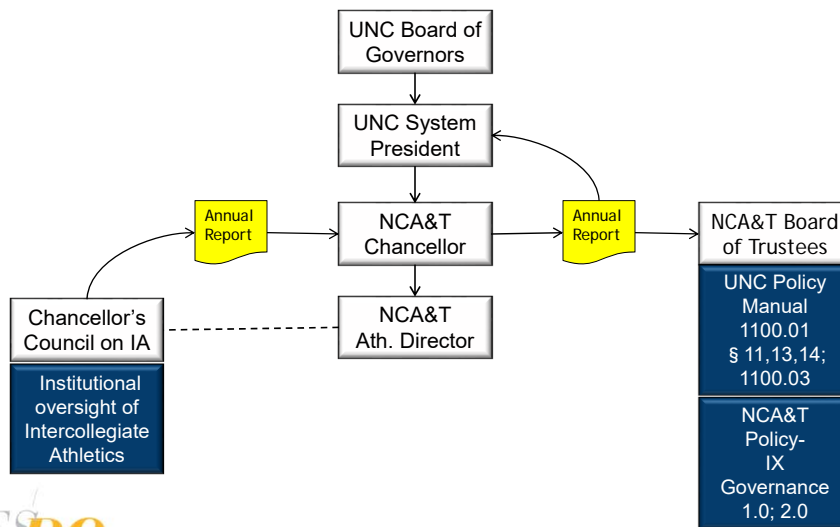

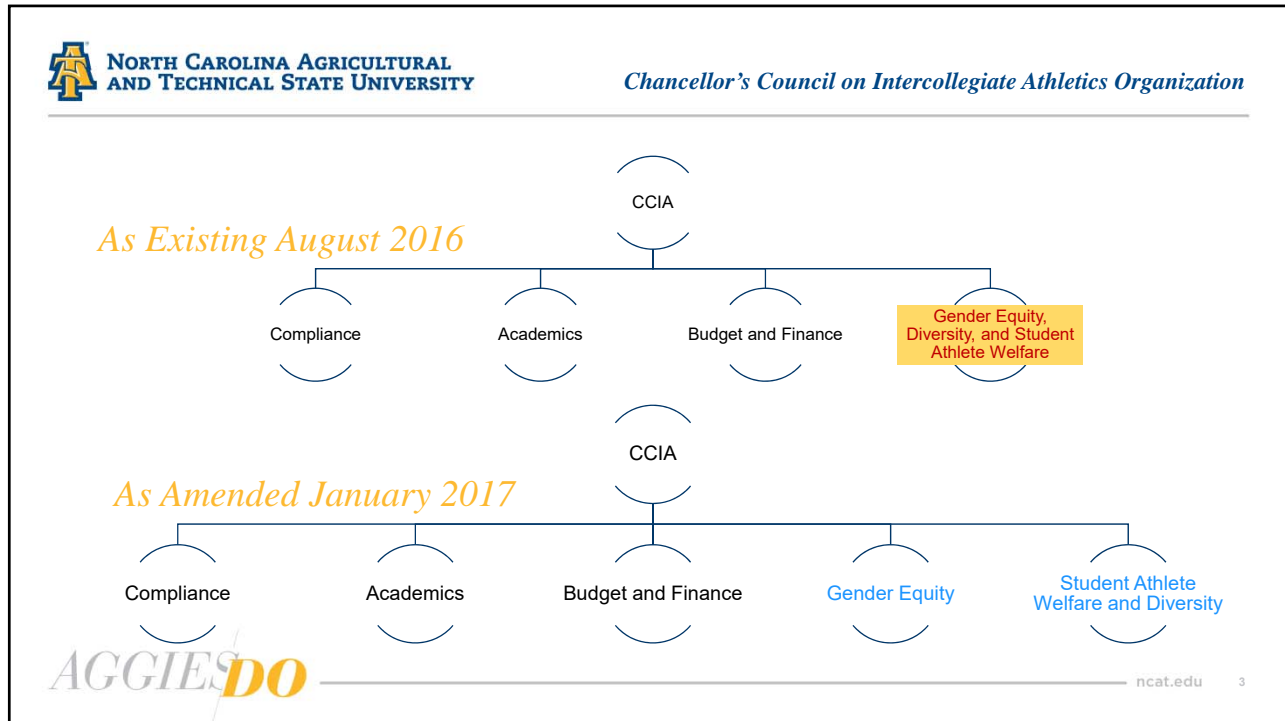

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**Academic Distribution Unit**

- New distribution model developed by NCAA which will allocate revenue to schools based on the academic achievement of their student-athletes
- Distribution projected to begin in 2019-2020 academic year
- Distribution amount projected to be \$55,000 – 500,000+ per year, per school which qualifies
- Qualification (proposed criteria) – SY Department APR of 985; GSR of 90%, or 13 percentage point difference between SA and student body FGR



**Time Demand Legislation (effective August 1, 2017)**

- Require the creation of a time management plan for each sport and an annual review of that plan
- Prohibit athletically related activities during a continuous eight-hour period between 9 p.m. and 6 a.m.
- Require a seven-day break after the season and 14 additional days off during the regular academic year when classes are in session
- Require a day off per week during preseason and vacation periods
- Prohibit off-campus practice during vacation periods outside the championship season and unrelated to away-from-home competition.

## Concussion Management Protocol

- Legislation introduced and passed regarding development of a Concussion Management Protocol for all autonomy-conference schools
- We submitted our revised Concussion Management Protocol to the NCAA for review and approval in April 2017
