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## HOUSING ALLOCATIONS

- Housing Occupancy has intentionally been reduced by 464 beds (8.3%) from 5587 beds to 5164 beds. More specifically, Cooper, Morrow, and Vanstory Residence Halls have been reduced by 50% to promote social distancing.
- The load on community style restrooms have been reduced such that they will have a range of 12 to 25 students who will utilize them
- Suite style residence halls will have a range of 2 to 8 students who will utilize a bathroom in a suite.
- Students in all apartments will have their own private bedroom and bathroom.



## Residence Life

- We will continue to work with the Office of Accessibility Services (OAR) to accommodate those students who request an ADA housing accommodations.
- Occupancy remains the same in suite style accommodations and will not change in Aggie Village or Aggie Suites E & F, Barbee and Pride Residence Halls.



## Residence Life

- We will implement a 3 tiered move-in process for select student groups. Each group will have a designated date, time and location to report to campus:
  - > *Special Populations: June 24<sup>th</sup> through August 6<sup>th</sup>*
  - > *New Students: August 5<sup>th</sup> through 9<sup>th</sup>*
  - > *Continuing Students: August 14<sup>th</sup> through 18<sup>th</sup>*
- All residence halls community areas will receive thorough cleaning 7 days per week, multiple times per day.



## Residence Life

- Students residing together as roommates and suitemates are considered a “family unit” and will be expected to practice the proper precautions to maintain a healthy environment (3 Ws - wear mask, wash hands, wait and maintain 6 feet distance from others)
- Visitation for the Fall 2020 semester is restricted and common area (*lobbies, study rooms, computer labs, laundry facilities, etc.*) capacities within residence halls will be limited.



## Residence Life

- Move-in Protocol will be sent to all residential students
- Quarantine/Isolation: Haley Hall has been selected with private bedrooms and shared bathroom suite style. (39 beds).
- Rules of engagement, signage, 3 W's (wear mask, wash hands, wait and maintain 6 feet distance from others)
- Residence hall expectations will be communicated to all students upon arrival during a series of virtual residence hall meetings facilitated by Housing and Residence Life staff members.

## Residence Life

## **DINING & RETAIL OPERATIONS**

- Seating capacities in dining facilities will be reduced to 50% of the maximum occupancy across campus.
- Dining areas will align with physical distancing guidelines including limited seating, six-foot spacing, adjusted flows of traffic, to-go options, contactless and touchless payment options, and restricting self-serve options.
- We will expand sanitation measures in all locations and provide additional cleaning services between meal hours.



## STUDENT CENTER AND CAMPUS RECREATION CENTER

- In collaboration with Dining Services, the Student Center will modify hours of operation:
  - > *Monday-Friday: 8am-10pm*
  - > *Saturday: 12pm-10pm*
  - > *Sunday: 2pm-10pm*
- Flow of traffic will be adjusted to align with physical distancing guidelines and signage will be placed in highly visible locations throughout the building.



## STUDENT CENTER AND CAMPUS RECREATION CENTER

- Extensive cleaning and disinfectant measures will be implemented with hourly sanitation throughout the facility.
- External individual and group event reservations are restricted for the Fall 2020 semester in the Student Center.
- Capacities for internal events will be limited and room layouts will reflect physical distancing guidelines at all times.



## Student Engagement

- Students will have access to virtual “return to campus trainings”. The trainings will include guidelines for maintaining a healthy environment.
- Students are expected to review training materials prior to arrival on campus.
- We will restrict large gatherings for the Fall 2020 semester and only permit gatherings of 10 indoors or 25 outdoors.



## Student Engagement

- Events larger than the aforementioned should transition to an online format or postpone to Spring 2021 (*i.e. Greek life activities, socials, comedy show, etc.*)
- Students are expected to follow physical distancing guidelines for all social gatherings.
- Use of Greek plots is permitted, with the expectation of physical distancing and use of masks.
