Overview for Parking Ordinance

- Applicable laws required by North Carolina General Statutes 116-44 provides a Universities Board of Trustees the authority to approve parking ordinances
- Allows N.C. A&T to address critical parking-related issues
- Provides guidance to students, faculty, staff and visitors
- Funds realized would be used to address other critical parking needs
- Provides clear expectations for parking on campus
- Aligns parking ordinances with other UNC-System Universities



Updates to Ordinance

- **Specific Cost Related to Rates and Fees (Section 2-2; Page 11)**
 - *Current* - Rate or fee changes require BOT to approve a new ordinance
 - *Replace* - Specific rates and fees shall be “approved in accordance with N.C. A&T policies and guidelines.”
- **License Plate Recognition Technology (Section 7; Page 26)**
 - Privacy issues related to image storage
- **Virtual Permit (Section 2-1; Page 10)**
 - License plate will become your new parking permit 2021/2022



Updates to Ordinance

- **New Freshman Policy for Parking (Section 2-1; Page 10)**
 - Effective Fall 2021, New Freshmen are not permitted to bring vehicles to campus their first year (Fall and Spring Semesters)
 - Freshmen with hardships encouraged to apply for waiver through Office of Student Development
- **Citation Guidelines**
 - No person or position is exempt from receiving a citation for violation of ordinances **(Section 5-1; Page 21)**
 - Director has direct and/or assigned authority over voids or fine reductions **(Section 5-1)**
 - New Application Process for Reserved Permit Holders with Campus Mobility Job Requirement **(Section 3-5; Page 17)**
 - Allow personal vehicle to be parked outside of assigned reserved space if deemed a job requirement **(Section 3-5; Page 17)**

N.C. A&T has drafted an ordinance update which is compliant with the applicable law for your review and approval

Following approval by Board, N.C. A&T will file document with UNC System President and Secretary of State as required in statutes
