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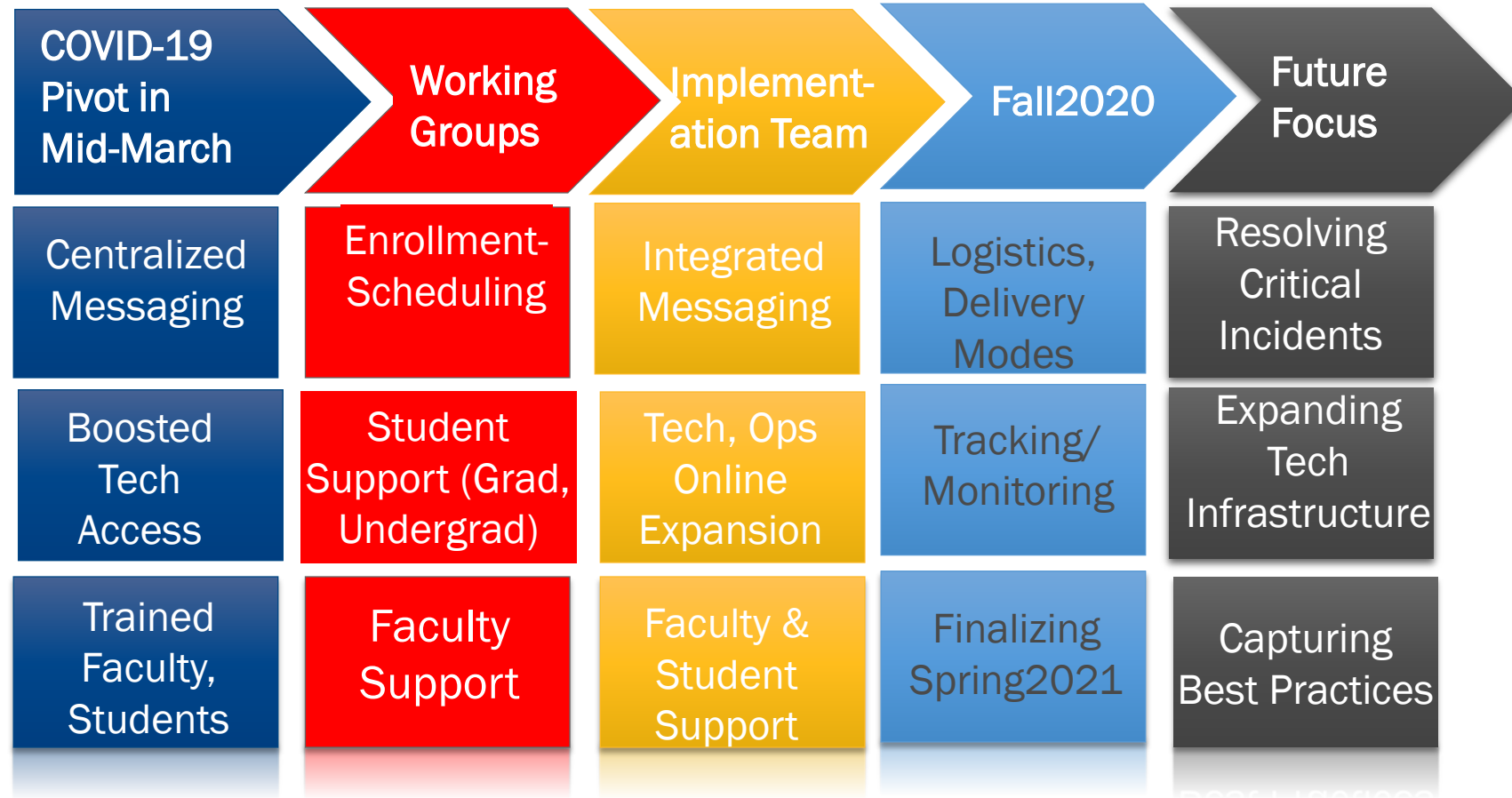

- **Teaching-Learning Continuity:** Specifies the “*how*” of UNC-mandated Academic Continuity. Since **March 4th**, our objectives focused on:
 - > High quality teaching and learning in virtual and on-campus classrooms
 - > Technology support, access and training
 - > Organization and flexibility around faculty needs
 - > Effective support services through virtual environments
 - > *Ultimately, student success, engagement and well-being*



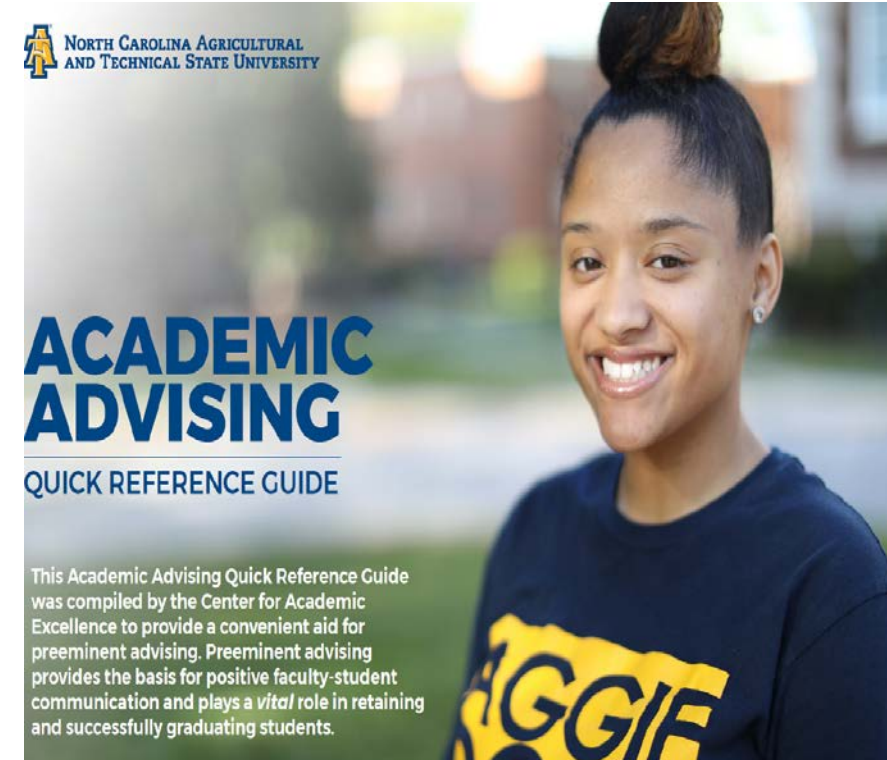


- Student Enrollment: 12,754; ~819 Faculty
 - > Students living on campus – 3815 (1586 1st time freshmen; 192 transfer; 2037 continuing)
- 60% online offerings; 40% on campus (Modes by student enrollment: 5% on-campus only; 39% fully online; 56% hybrid.)
- Over 200 courses with online delivery mode (109% increase from last fall)
- Open educational resources for textbook savings
- 140/160 classrooms instrumented with microphones and webcams as prioritized by deans
- Spring 2021 calendar revised

- Expanded Library Services, including loaner laptops
- Increased virtual support for student success
 - > Quick Reference Advising Guide (faculty, students)
 - > Remote learning guide; tutoring; general advising Zoom room
 - > Virtual events to facilitate student engagement – AggiesMobilize, student orgs, speaker series, orientations, etc.
 - > Tech solutions, such as QR code- Smartphone app and expanded automated phone triage
 - > Blue and Gold Table Talks (SGA)
