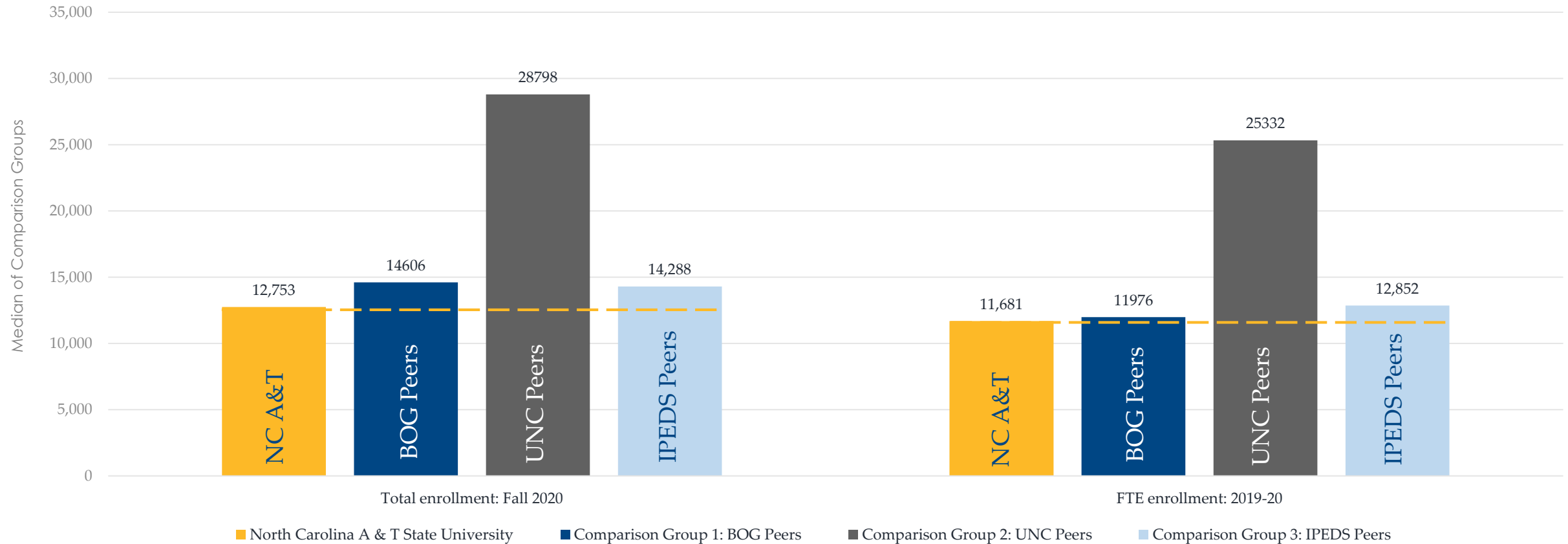

**12-month FTE enrollment and Total Fall enrollment**

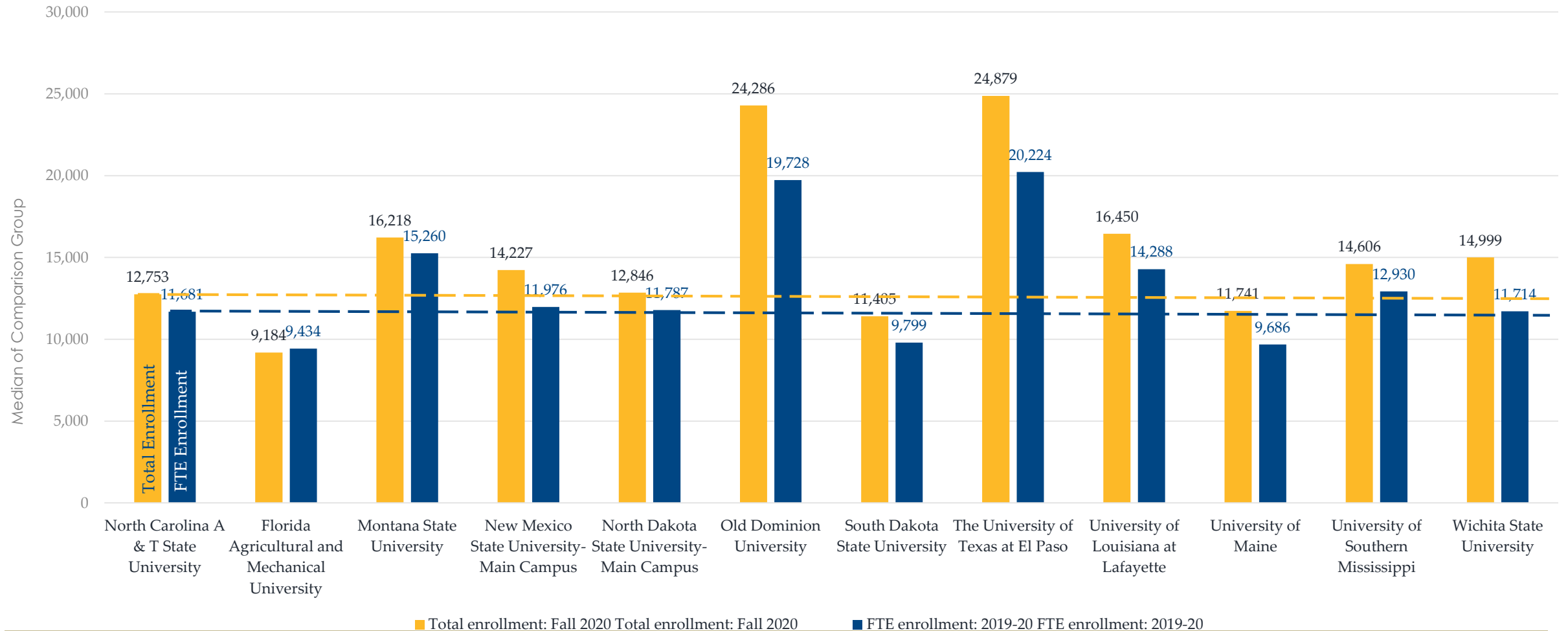

**12-month FTE enrollment and Total Fall enrollment: BOG Peers**

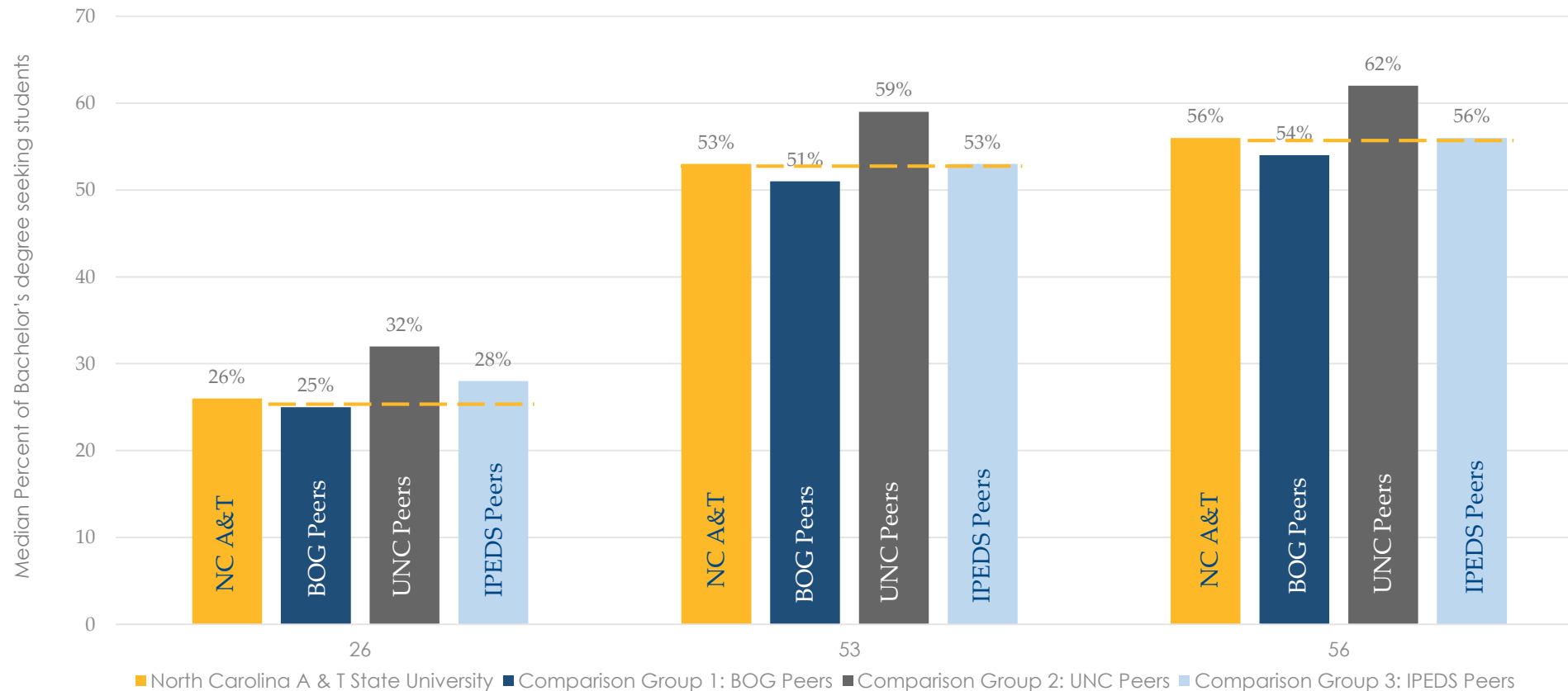

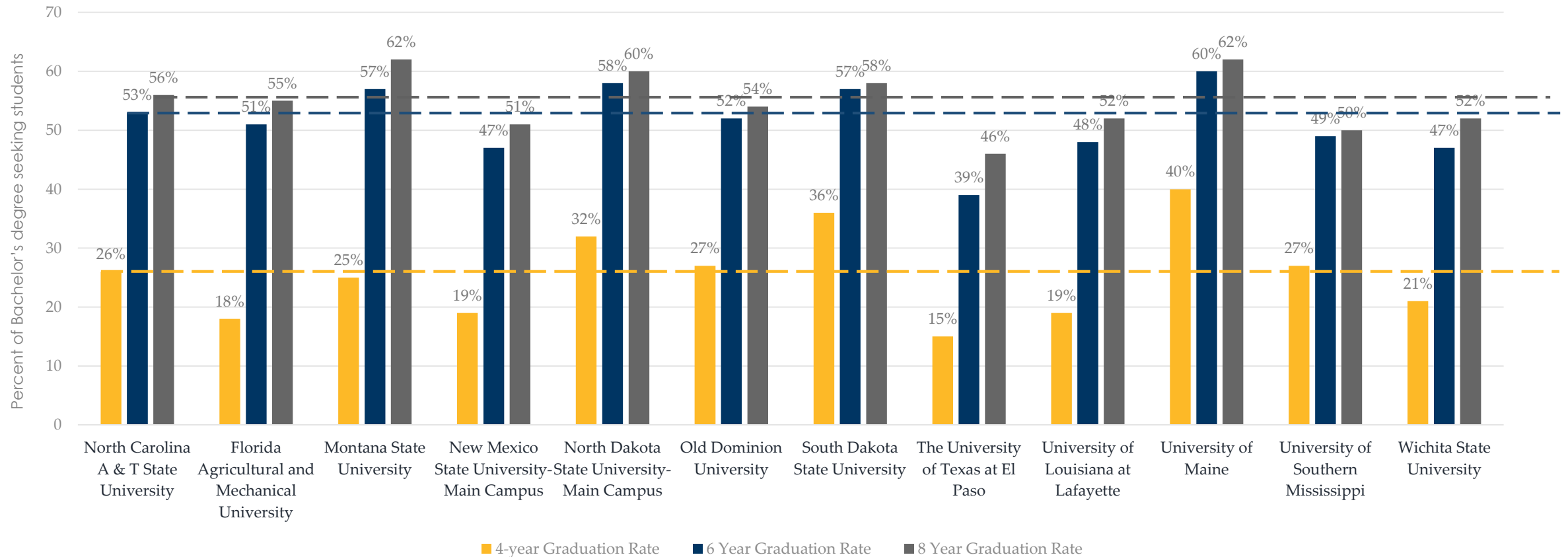
### 4, 6 and 8 Year Graduation Rate Comparison

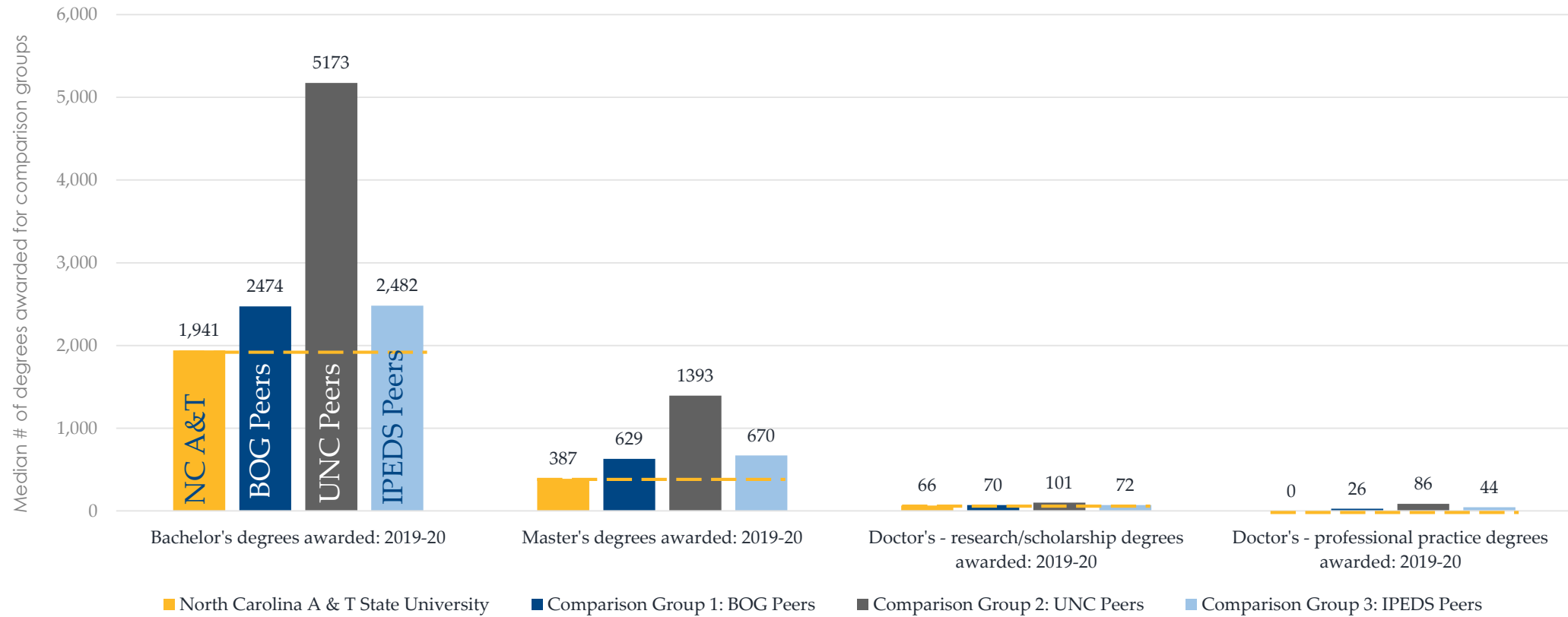

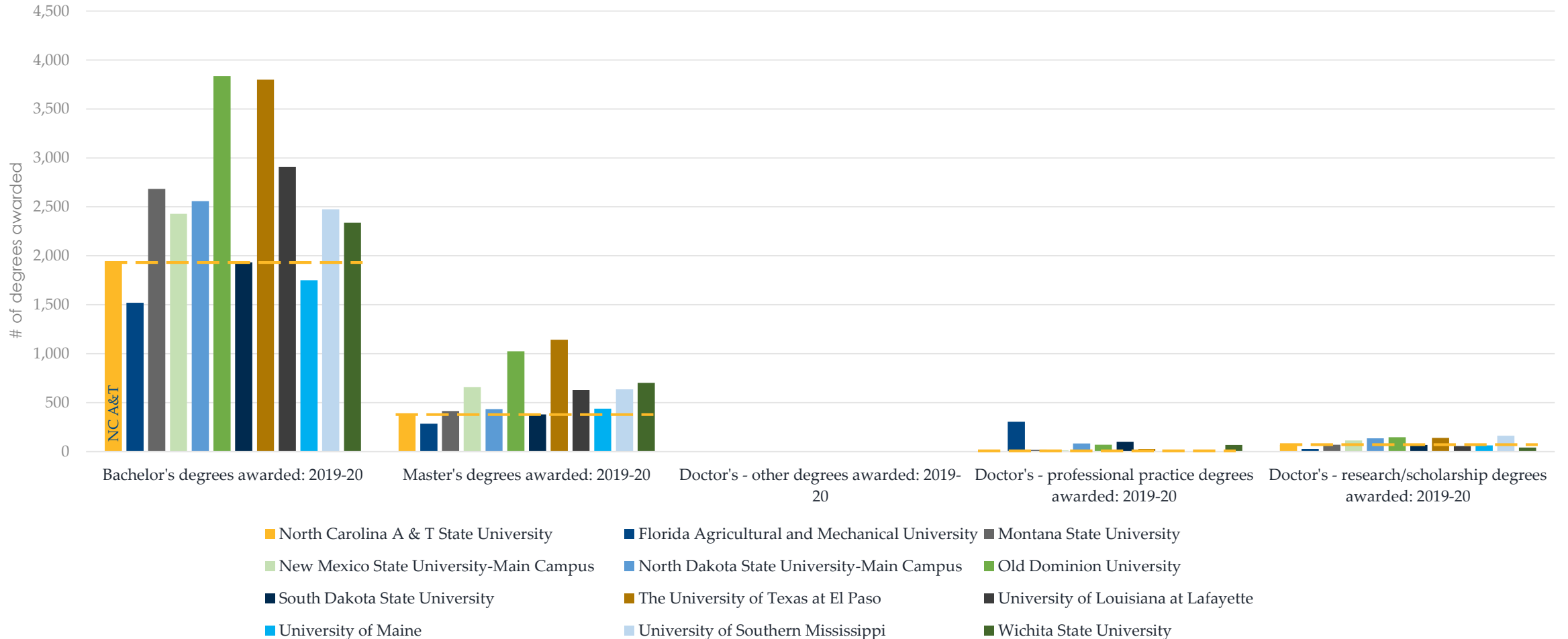

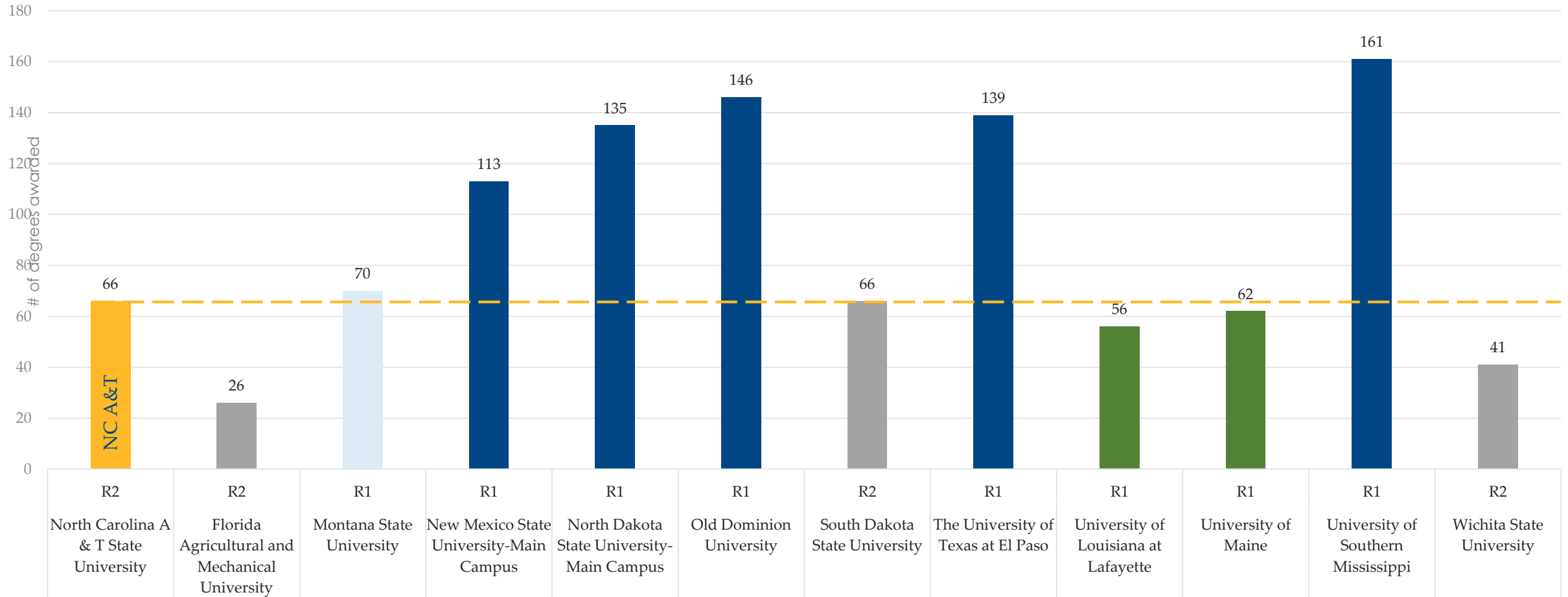

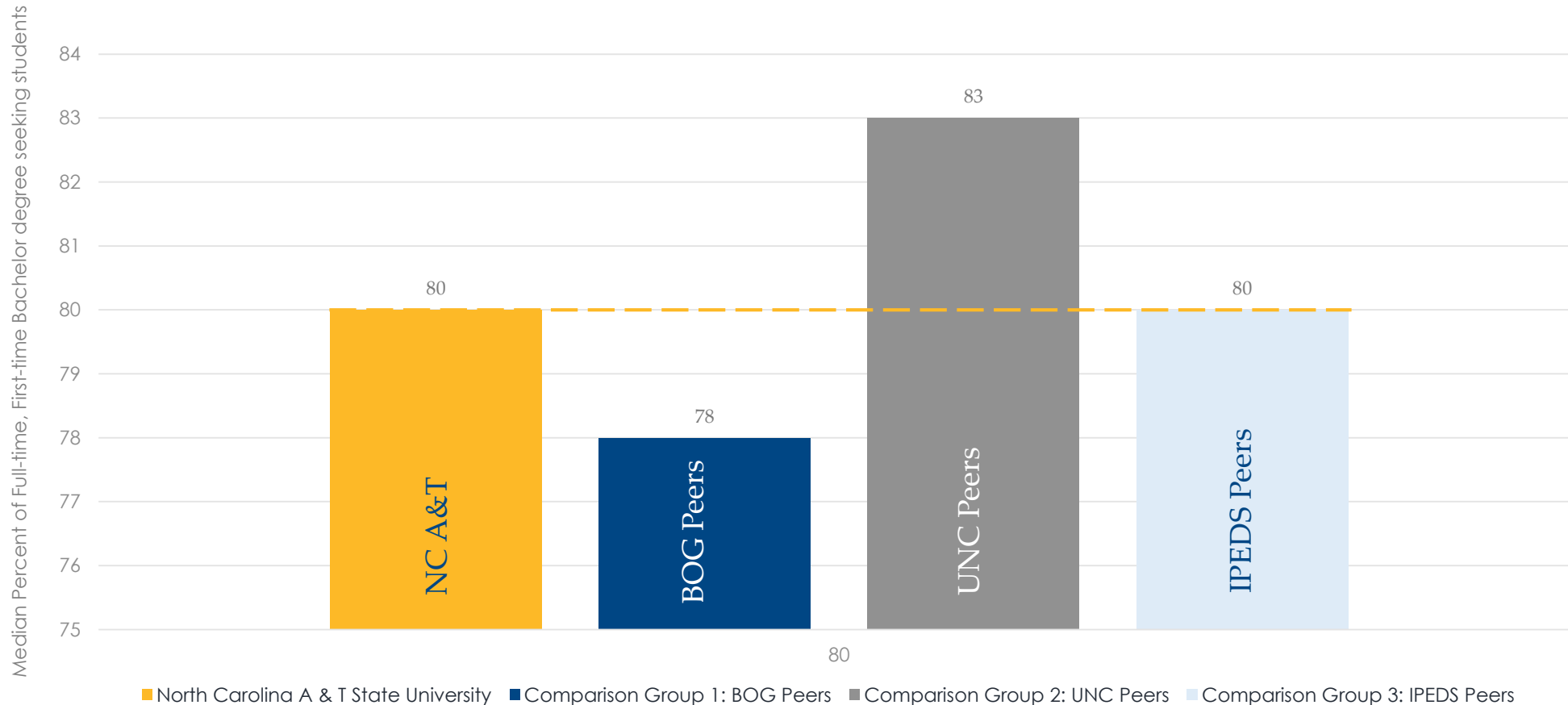
**Degrees Awarded by Level for Doctoral Research: BOG Peers**

**First-Year Retention Rate Comparison**

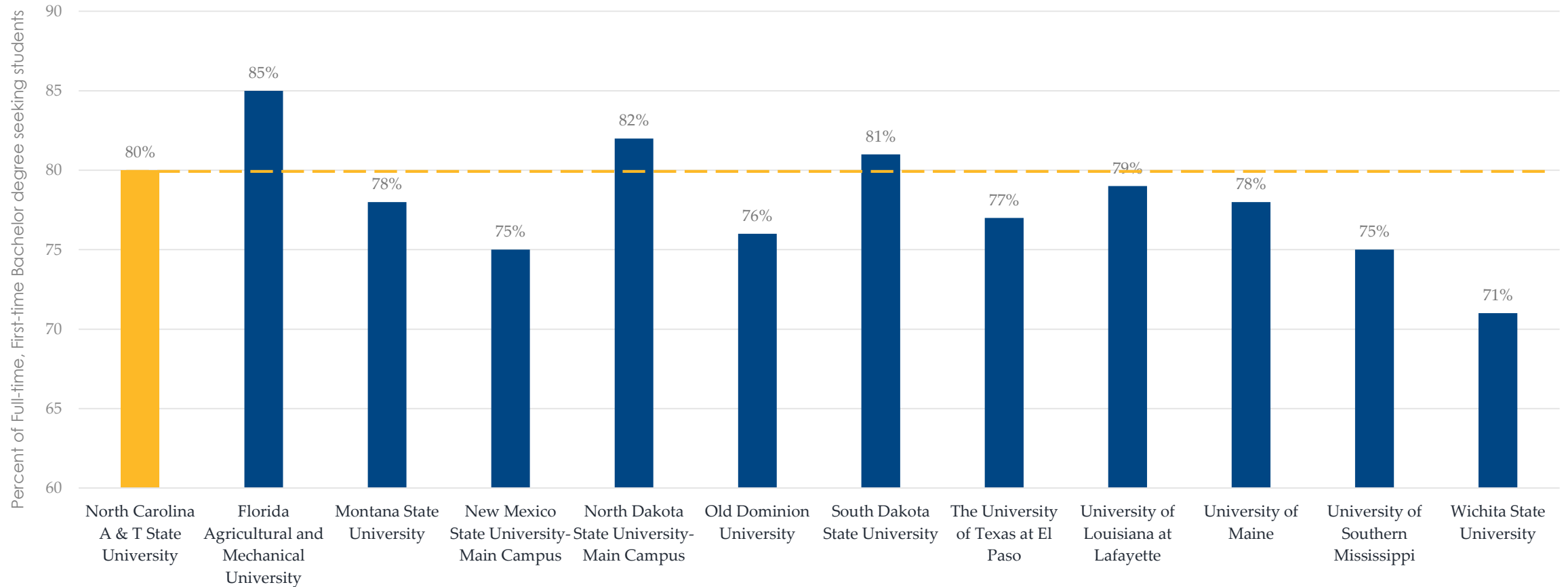
Percent of Full-time, First-time, Bachelor's degree seeking, Undergraduate students in Fall 2019 returning in Fall 2020

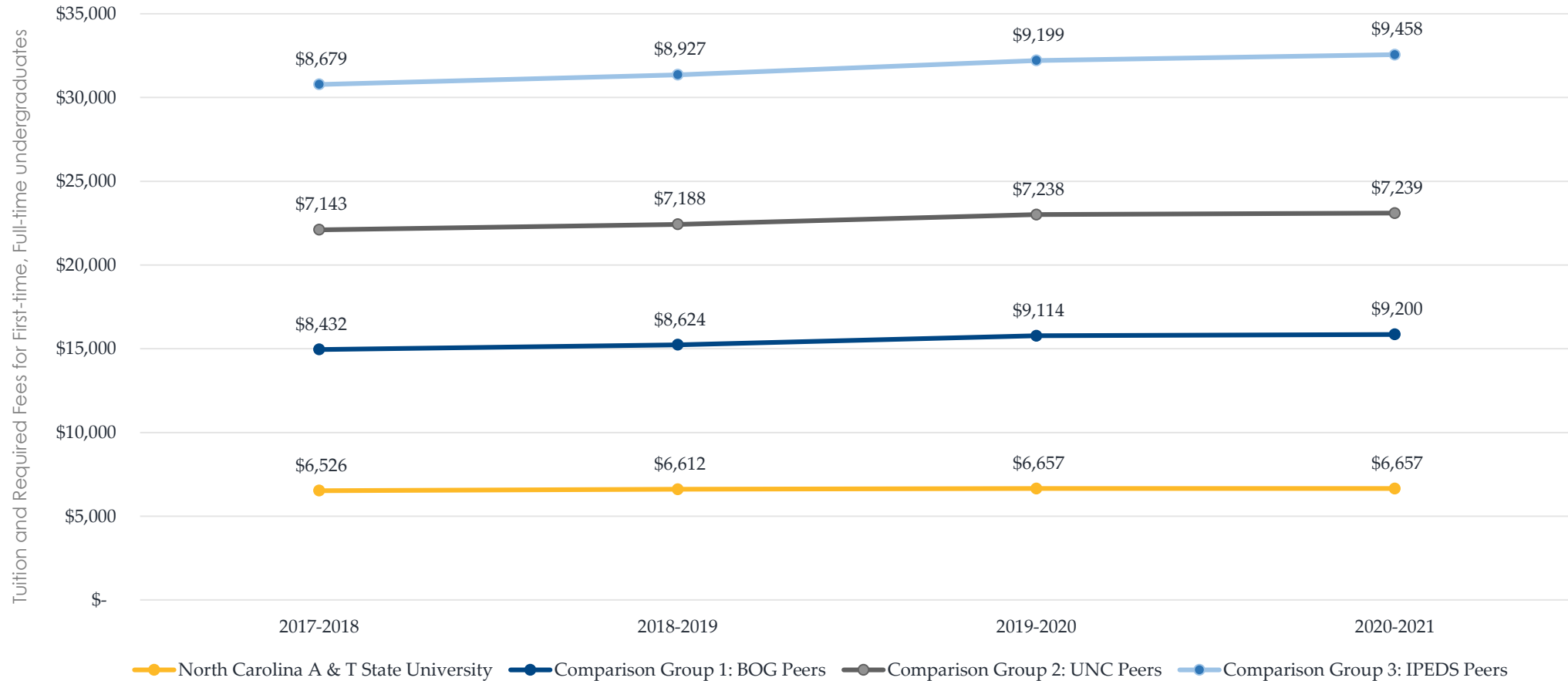

## Tuition and required fees for full-time, first-time degree/certificate-seeking undergraduates

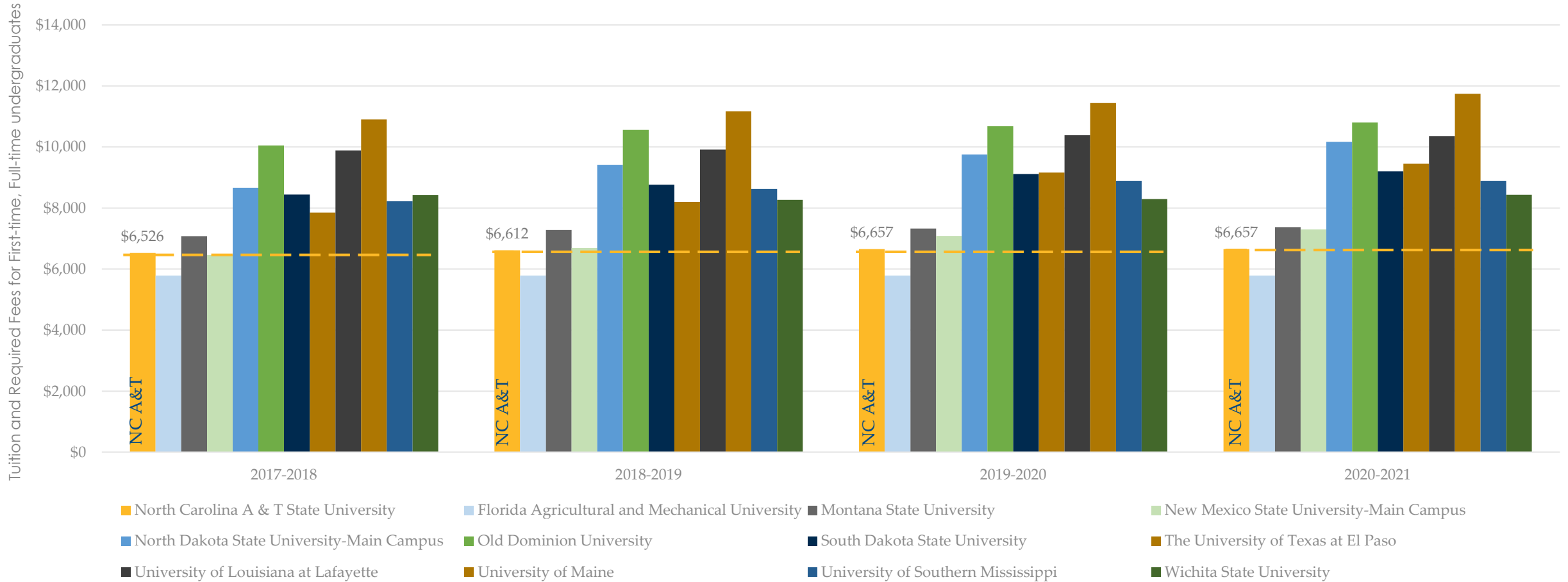
Academic years 2017-18 to 2020-21

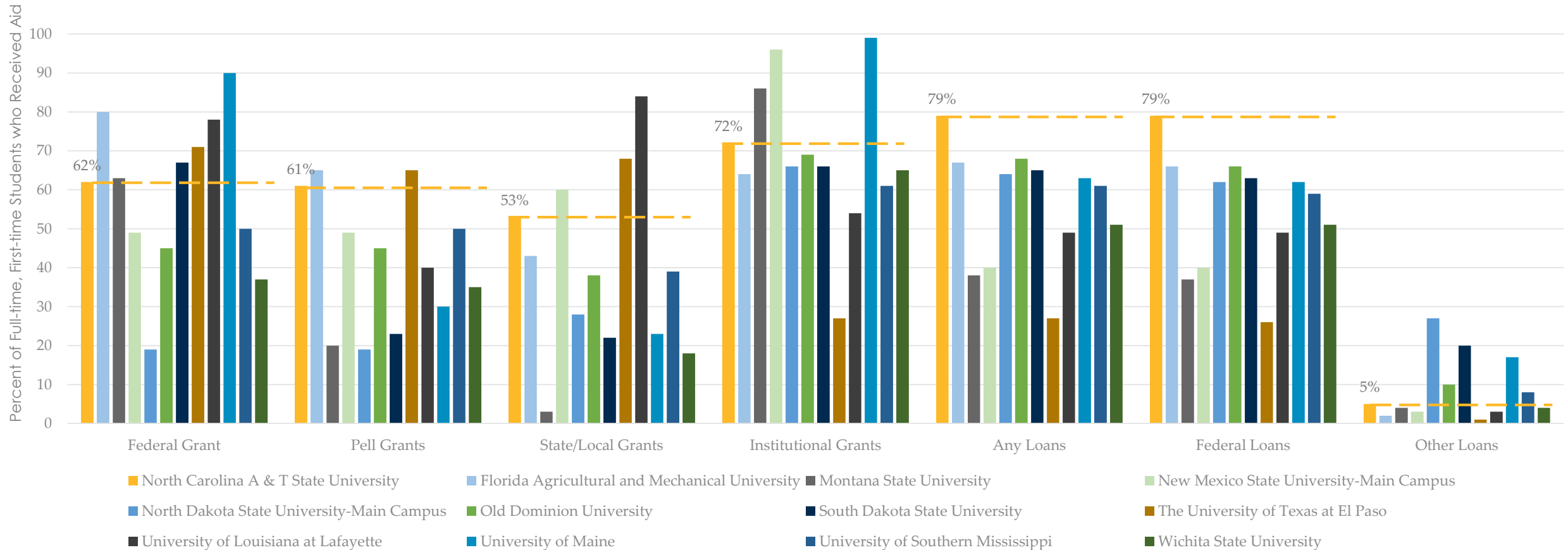

**Percent of full-time, first-time degree/certificate-seeking undergraduate students who were awarded grant or scholarship aid, or loans by type of aid**

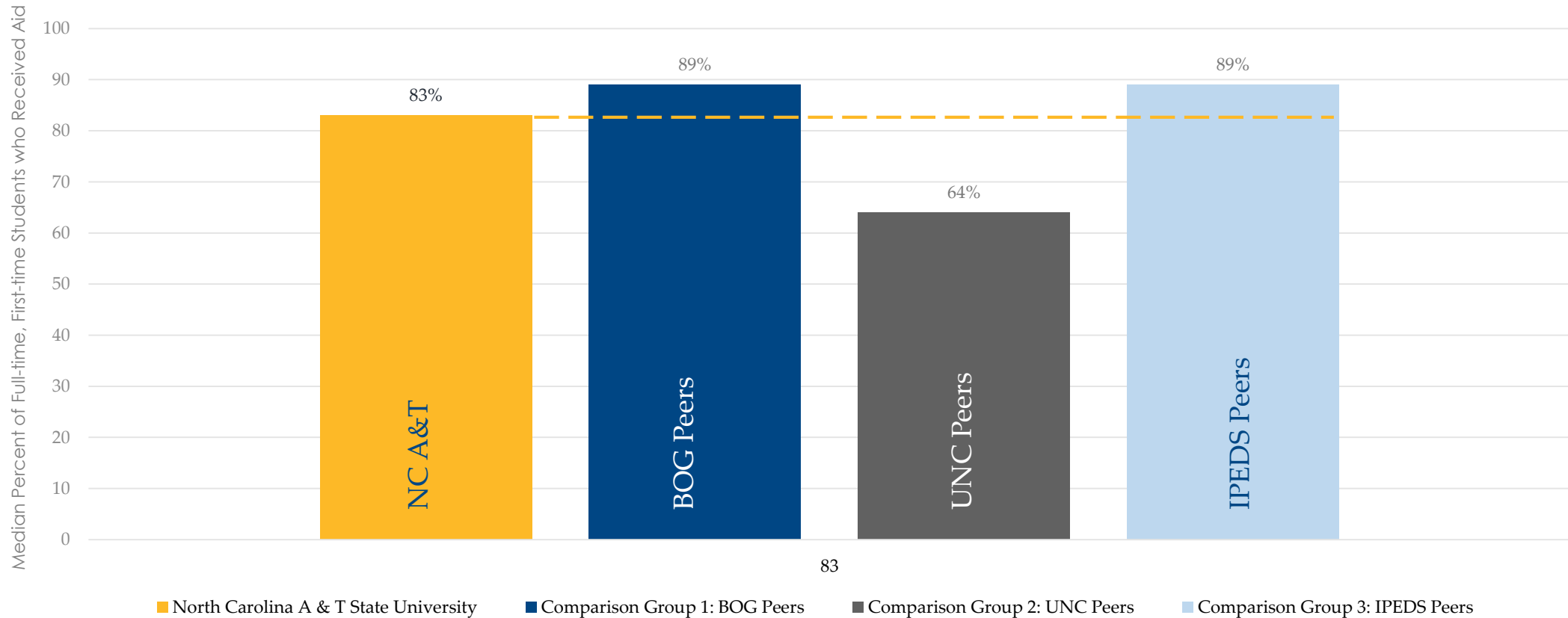

**Percent of full-time, first-time degree/certificate-seeking undergraduate students who were awarded any type of aid**

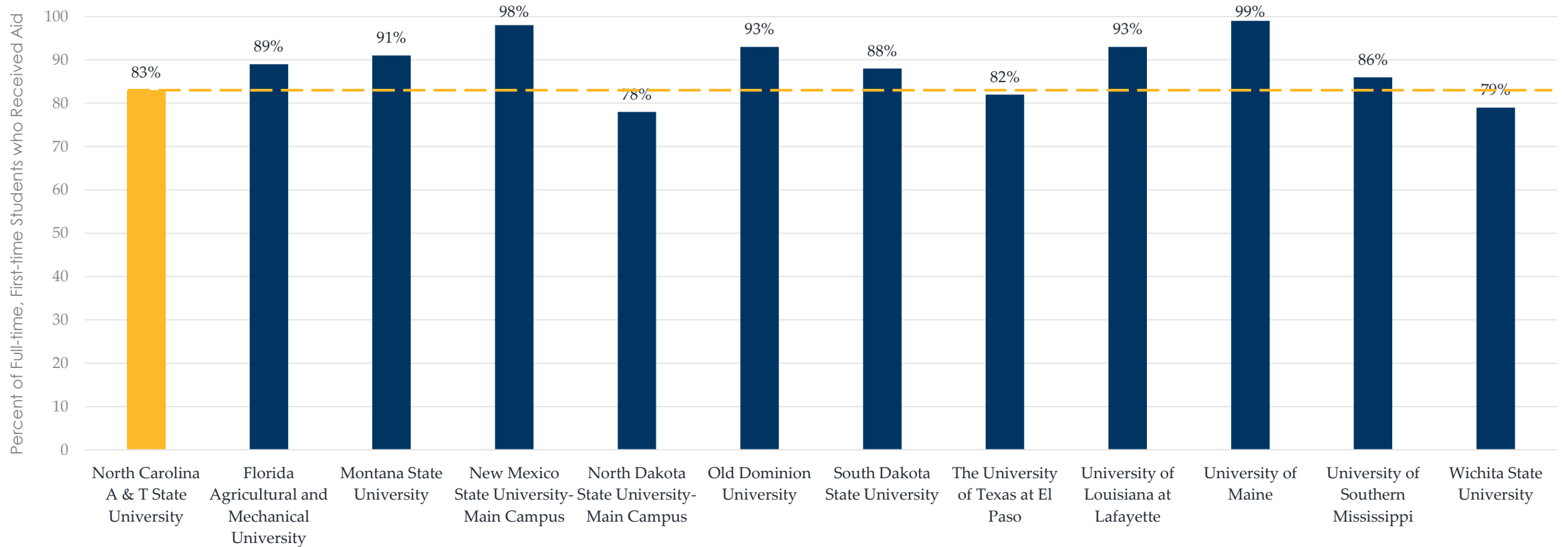
