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## AGGIE MOBILE PROGRAM - UNLIMITED POSSIBILITIES (AMP-UP)

- An Apple iPad initiative for teaching and learning in the critical first-year of student's university experience.
- Tied initiative to Strategic Goal 1: Invest in evidence-based initiatives to improve undergraduate student success.
- Strategic Deployment to accurately measure and gauge success of the investment.
- IT piloted security measures and deployment of iPads to faculty and students

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# MEASURING THE SUCCESS OF AMP-UP:



Approximately 4700 Recipients so far:

- First-time-Full-time Freshmen,
- Student Athletes,
- Honor Students,
- TriO,
- Student Rosters of the selected faculty.
- Selected faculty participating in any of the three sub-initiatives

*Started with a strategic deployment to support three sub-initiatives:*

- **AMPing-UP: General Education Courses**
  - > Piloting General Education Courses developing iPad pedagogy with first-time freshmen
- **Apple iPad Scholarship of Teaching & Learning (SoTL) Faculty Research Grant**
  - > Faculty research proposals using iPads as the primary tool in teaching and learning
  - > Select faculty are required to publish a paper of their results
- **AMPing-UP for Early Adopters**
  - > Faculty who volunteer to engage students with the iPad in the classroom.

NOTE: Students were required to sign a Student User Agreement to include the expectation of graduating within 4 years..

Interest has continued to grow from both faculty and students.

# NCA&T APPLE SOTL INITIATIVE – TITLE III PROJECT

- Goal: To foster inter-university collaborations and scholarly convergence of the use of iPad technologies in the classroom.
- Funding for faculty to creatively incorporate iPad technologies, tools and software into classroom instruction - \$1000 per person for classroom materials, SoTL publications, or SoTL conferences
