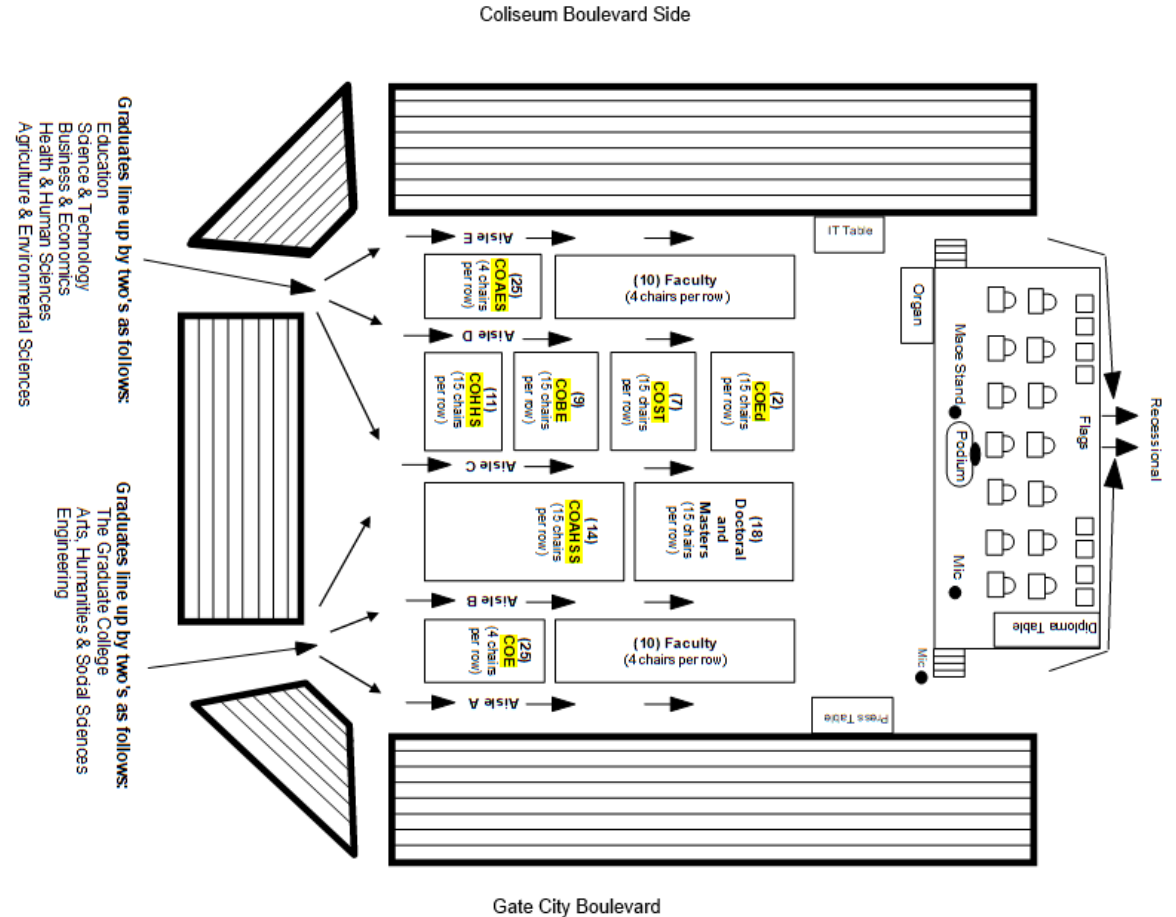
Program
