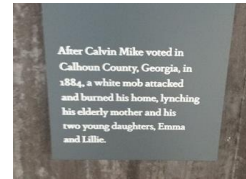
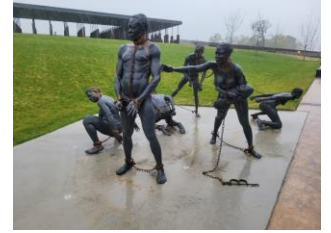

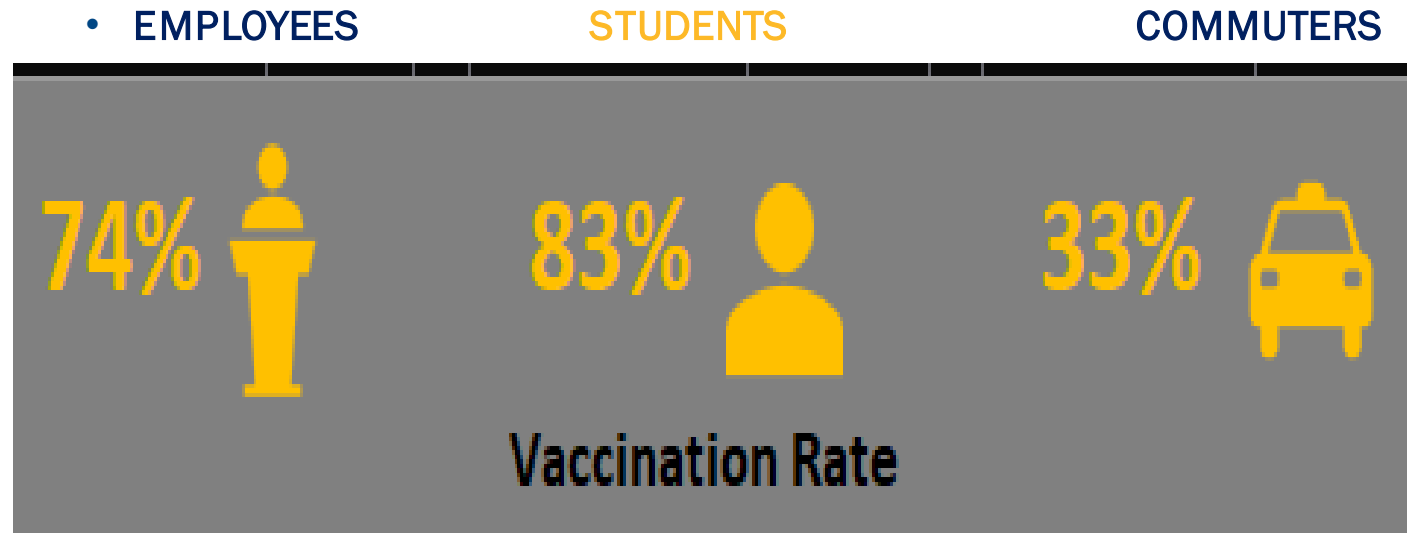

CURRENT GUIDANCE FOR CAMPUS

Masks are always encouraged

- Masks Optional **EXCEPT**
 - > Research labs, Public Transportation and Health facilities
- Highly recommend continued masking for:
 - > High risk diagnoses
 - > Unvaccinated
- Those who have or are exposed to COVID-19
- Discontinued mandatory testing (including entrances at campus events)
- Continue symptomatic testing and address clusters
- Wastewater surveillance
